This modular system is available in 2/3 tiers and in several lay-outs. The system consists of a combination of nest and slat rows that can be arranged in different layouts to best suit the poultry house.

Good accessibility

This robust system is designed and manufactured for easy construction. The birds have good accessibility into the system. Nests, feed, water and several perches can be reached easily. High densities up to 18 birds/m² floor space are possible. Eggs are well protected as they roll from the nest gently to the egg belt. The metal rear wall of the nest can be folded down entirely allowing for easy access and thorough cleaning. Furthermore, the complete nest floor structure can be easily removed for cleaning and access.

Total comfort

Due to the low height of the systems the overview is perfect. The Combi-barn system can be placed in low buildings with a 2,4 ceiling height. The floor is made of galvanised wire that guarantees total comfort and support for the feet of the birds in any position. The floors are sloped so system eggs can be collected easily at the outer side. The birds are very evenly spread throughout the system at different levels. Manure removal belts are installed under each level of slatted floor which contributes to a healthy environment for your birds.



This is the system to choose when you have concerns about the quality of the rearing of your birds. The system can be closed at several stages allowing you to give the birds some extra training in how to behave in an aviary system.

Control and overview are two key words belonging to the High Rise. The overview over the birds is good and you have easy access to the nest- and slatted areas due to a central walk alley.



Nests, feed, water, perches and slatted area are easily reachable by the birds. The slope of the floor towards the nest makes sure the eggs roll into the nest to avoid having eggs visible in the system. Perches in front of the nest can be lifted creating more space for catching and cleaning.

Manure removal belts are installed under each level of slatted floor which contributes to a healthy environment for the birds.


Unique of the manure removal is the stainless steel scraper which cleans the belt perfectly and has the possibility to track the belt of the end of the row. Due to the design of a raised system the HR3 gives the opportunity to use the whole barn width as usable space.

The birds have easy access to the nests, feed, water and perches due to short distances. The unique, 5-corner shaped Salmest perch is comfortable for the hen to walk on.


